### ORDER

1. Whereas, the AICTE is a statutory body established by AICTE Act, 1987. The said Act "provides for establishment of an All India Council for Technical Education with a view to the proper planning and co-ordinate development of the technical education system throughout the country, the promotion of qualitative improvement of such education in relation to planned quantitative growth and the regulation of proper maintenance of norms and standards in the technical education system and for matters connected therewith."
2. Whereas, Section 10 of the AICTE Act prescribes the function of the Council and mandates that it shall be the duty of the Council to take all necessary steps and it may think fit for ensuring coordinated and integrated development of technical education and maintenance of standards. Further, Section 10 (k) of the AICTE Act, empowers the AICTE to grant approval for starting new Technical Institutions and for introduction of new courses or programmes in consultation with the agencies concerned.
3. Whereas, in order to discharge its duties in accordance with the provisions contained in the AICTE Act the AICTE has framed the regulations for grant of approval for starting new Technical Institutions, introduction of courses or programmes and increase / variation of intake capacity of seats for the courses or programmes of existing Technical Institutions. The AICTE has also evolved a Handbook for approval process which details out the procedure as well as minimum conditions which an Institute must fulfill in order to seek approval for either starting new Technical Institutions or for introduction of courses / programmes as increase / variation of intake capacity of seat for courses / programmes as well as existing Technical Institute.
4. Whereas, **Azad Institute of Pharmacy & Research, Lucknow, U.P.** had applied Under Chapter-II for introduction of a **new Pharmacy course at Diploma Level.**
5. Whereas, the Council conducted a surprise visit to the Institute on 17/03/2017, which brought out various deficiencies with regard to building / built-up / instructional/ administrative/ amenities area/ faculty or anti- ragging etc.
6. Whereas, the case was placed before the SHC held on 02-04-2017 but the Institute was **absent** on that day. However, as requested by the Institute, the case was placed before the SHC on 06.04.2017. The Institute attended the SHC. The recommendation of the SHC is as under.

Institute: Azad Institute of Pharmacy & Research, Lucknow, U.P



**“The Institutes representatives have submitted the documents for removal of deficiencies. Barring short-fall in faculty & availability of language lab, compliance for rest of the deficiencies have been met. In view of this, SHC recommends EOA for existing courses for AY 2017-18 may be granted, & No approval for the newly applied diploma in Pharmacy course”.**

7. Whereas an order dated 11.04.2017 was issued to the Institute intimating the above recommendation. The institute appealed for consideration by the SAC. The SAC held on 21.04.2017 observed the deficiencies:

8. Whereas, taking into consideration, the evidences/relevant documents shown/submitted by the institution and after hearing the submissions of the Institute’s representatives, the SAC submitted the following final decision/recommendations.

**“Extension of approval for existing courses only be granted for the A.Y.2017-18.”**

9. Whereas, after examining the entire mater in the facts and circumstances mentioned herein above, and in terms of the provision of the Approval Process Hand Book A/Y 2017-18 and guidelines and also the terms and conditions mentioned in the Letter of Approval, it has



been decided by the Council that **Azad Institute of Pharmacy & Research, Lucknow, U.P.** be granted "**EOA for existing courses only**" for the academic year 2017-18.
